



# SPRING 2010 BRUSH CHIPPING PROGRAM



In an effort to ensure cleaner air for the Province of British Columbia, the GVRD Metro Vancouver will no longer be issuing Class B Permits (yard clean up fires).

It is recommended that you take advantage of our Chipping Program in hopes to benefit our environment.

**The Village will be accepting phone calls between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. weekdays to request chipping services** for the disposal of tree and shrub branches up to 6 inches in diameter. Residents are asked to place the branches on the roadside at their property. The "pile" of **only branches** can have a total volume of 4 cubic meters (*4 feet wide, 4 feet high and a maximum of 9 feet long*).

When phoning in to be placed on the chipping list, we ask that you provide the approximate volume of material to be chipped. Unfortunately, no construction waste, building materials, stumps, vines such as blackberries, root balls, or household waste will be permitted.
