CHIEF ELECTION OFFICER APPOINTED FOR ANMORE BY-ELECTION

Honourable Bill Bennett, Minister of Community and Rural Development on February 26th, 2010 appointed a Chief Election Officer to conduct a By-Election for the Village of Anmore. This appointment was made under Section 38(1)(a) of the Local Government Act. It should be noted that the Province of British Columbia will not pay for any costs associated with the appointment of the Chief Election Officer or the cost of holding the By-Election.

The Chief Election Officer for the upcoming By-Election will be Sarah M. Morden. Ms. Morden operates Defero-West, a Local Government Consulting firm. Ms. Morden has a Masters Degree in Public Administration concentrating on Local Government Management from the University of Victoria and has received her Intermediate Certificate in Local Government Administration by the BC Board of Examiners.

Now that an appointment has been made, the By-Election will be held on May 15th, 2010.

Thank-you to Councillor John McEwen who was very instrumental in encouraging Minister Bennett to appoint a Chief Election Officer.
